ABSTRACT

Hridraya is an epitome of sustenance and co-ordination to maintain *Ayu*. It is considered as one of the three *Marma sthana*, and is the seat of *Sarira, Buddhi, Indriya, Indriyarth, Saguna atma, Mana*, etc so, any deviation in its functioning can be tremendously bereaving. *Acharya Charaka, Sushruta, Vagbhata* and *Bhela* have been unanimous regarding *Hridaya* being the seat of *Manas* and *Buddhi*. *Hridroga* is an ocean full of disease entities. In contemporary medical system, it is known as CVD i.e., Cardio-Vascular Disease. CVDs are the leading cause of death taking an estimated 17.9 million lives in 2019 accounting for whooping 32% of all the global deaths. Most cardiovascular diseases can be prevented by addressing behavioural risk factors such as tobacco use, unhealthy diet and obesity, physical inactivity and harmful use of alcohol. These risk factors can be effectively tackled by the judicious adherence to *Dinacharya, Ratricharya, Ritucharya, Sadvritta niyamas*, etc. Even in the state of disease, compliance with *Sodhana* procedures and *Oushadhas* can lead to alleviation of disease and qualitative improvement in the state of *Ayu*. This article gives 360° view of *Shaman oushadhas* related to *Hridroga*, which is explained by the *Apta* in various ancient texts.

INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is considered as science of life, which targets physical, mental, spiritual and social well-being to enhance the quality of life. *Hridaya*, literally translates from its root words as *Hri*, which means "to give," *Da*, which means "to take," and *Ya* from *yam*, which means "balance." So, it is a perfect example for the balance or sustenance. *Hridaya* is formed from the combination of essence part of the *Rakta* and *Kapha*. The contractions, conductivity, rhythm, tonicity and blood supply depends on the equilibrium of *Doshas*. *Vegadharana, Ruksha, Ushna, Snigdha* and *Athi matra ahara* and also *Avyayama* leads to the aggravation of *Doshas*, which inturn vitiates the *Rasa* present in the

heart and gives rise to pain in the heart, which is known as *Hridroga*. *Charaka* classifies *Hridroga* under 5 types on the basis of *Doshas* such as *Vataja, Pittaja, Kaphaja, Sannipataja* and *Krimija* whereas *Susrutha* says *Hridroga* is of 4 types- *Vataja, Pittaja, Kaphaja* and *Krimija*. Symptomatically *Hridroga's* are correlated to Cardio Vascular Diseases (CVDs) and treatment is adopted accordingly. CVDs are group of disorders of the heart and blood vessels and include coronary heart disease, cerebrovascular disease, rheumatic heart disease, aortic atherosclerosis and peripheral arterial disease. The industrialization of the economy with a resultant shift from physically demanding to sedentary jobs, along with the current consumerism and technology-driven culture that is related to longer work hours, longer commutes, and less leisure time for recreational activities, may explain the significant and steady increase in the rates of CVD during the last few decades. To reduce the incidence of *Hridroga*, this article focuses on the treatment aspect briefing the formulations from important Ayurvedic texts.

DISCUSSION

Life is possible only with the coordination of all the three *Doshas*, *Dhatus*, and *Malas*. According to *Charaka* and *Susrutha*, *Hridaya* is the *Moola* of *Pranavaha srotas* and *Rasa vaha srotas*, it can be correlated to the functioning of pulmonary and circulatory systems. The most important behavioural risk factors of heart disease and stroke are unhealthy diet, physical inactivity, tobacco use and harmful use of alcohol. Other determinants of CVDs include poverty, stress and hereditary factors. *Hridroga nidana* itself is complex, this *Nidana* leads to the formation of *Ama* which can be understood as atherosclerotic plaque or thrombo-embolism. This build-up of plaque causes *Sanga* type of *Srotodushti* of *Rasavaha*, *Rakta vaha* and *Prana vaha srotas*. This *Srotodushti* manifests in the malfunctioning of *Hridaya* which untimely deteriorates the quality of lifestyle and takes away the *Prana* (life). Role of all the *Doshas* i.e., *Tridosha* is vital in the pathogenesis of *Hridroga*; among them too *Vata* is predominantly responsible. The dominancy of *Dosha* also depends upon the type of *Hridroga*. So, drugs having *Hridya* property like *Arjuna*, *Karpura*, *Hritpatri*, *Vana palandu*, *Tambula*, *Karavira*, *Pita Karavira*, *Taruni*, etc are used in it. *Arjuna* is having *Kapha-pitta samana* property due to its *Kashaya rasa*, *Laghu*, *Ruksha guna* it suppresses *Kapha dosha* while because of *Shita virya*, the *Pitta dosha* is suppressed. Also, due to the *Kashaya rasa* and *Ruksha guna* the suppression of *Medo dhatu* takes place which remains the main culprit in the formation of plague. Prevention of *Hridroga* is by addressing behavioural risk factors such as tobacco use, unhealthy diet and obesity, physical inactivity and

harmful use of alcohol which can be easily obtained by compliance with the life style modification *Niyamas* like *Dinacharya*, *Ratricharya*, *Ritucharya* and *Sadvritta palana*. By these pathways, world can march towards the *Swasthya hridaya*. Treatment of *Hridroga* by the use of correct formulation not only targets the *Sampraphi* of the disease, but it also targets the underlying cause such as hypertension, diabetes and high blood lipids which further reduces cardiovascular risk and prevents heart attacks and strokes among people.

CONCLUSION

Hridroga is complicated in terms of diagnosis and management, identifying those at highest risk of *Hridroga* and ensuring they receive appropriate treatment can prevent premature deaths. It is evident that Ayurveda possesses vast number of formulations for *Hridroga*, This ancient treasure should be put through various trials for the generation of evidence to provide benefit to *Hridrogis* all around the globe. This article is a small effort in the classification of mentioned drugs into single drugs, mineral drugs, *Churnas*, *Ghrita*, *Vati*, *Tailas*, *Asava*, *Arista* and *Guggulu*. Access to these formulations compiled from the *Apthas* can reduce the burden for researchers who are going to contribute in the field of *Hridroga*.
